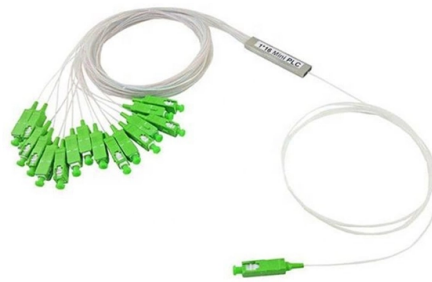


Cable Protection for Secondary Distribution Boxes

Key Principles of Cable Protection

- 1. Cable Insulation and Flame Retardancy** Cables used in secondary distribution systems should have flame-retardant insulation to prevent fire propagation in case of faults. For tripping circuits or critical DC systems, cables with adequate cross-sectional area are required to maintain voltage levels and ensure proper operation of protection devices under load or battery-only conditions .
- 2. Segregation and Routing** Cables should be physically separated based on function (e.g., protection, control, and power) to prevent a single fire or mechanical event from disabling multiple systems. Segregation also reduces electromagnetic interference and ensures signal integrity for CT/VT circuits . Routing should minimize cable length between the distribution board, battery, and loads to reduce voltage drop and simplify maintenance .
- 3. Redundancy and Reliability** Critical secondary systems, especially in high-voltage substations (220 kV and above), often employ duplicate DC systems. Each system includes a battery, charger, and distribution board, with parallel feeding to ensure continuity in case of a single fault . Redundant protection groups (Group A and Group B) should not share CT cores to maintain independent operation .
