

Fiber optic cable from 1982



Overview

The GI fiber-based optical fiber transmission system was adopted in 1982 for actual use after commercial test in 1980. In the second period, development of single mode (SM) fiber*2 also began using the MCVD method. By late August 1982 a length of 18.25 km of lightweight fiber optic submarine cable, type SL, had been manufactured by Simplex, and the cable and a repeater with two 274 MB/s regenerators were ready for test.
