

Fiber optic cables and high-voltage lines are laid in the same trench

Maintaining adequate separation from HV cables is critical to avoid capacitive coupling, dry-band arcing, or tracking on the fiber cable jacket caused by strong electric fields. The separation distance depends on the voltage level, cable insulation, and trench configuration.

Installation Practices

- Direct burial or conduit pulling: Fiber optic cables can be installed using plowing, trenching, or pulling through pre-installed conduits.
