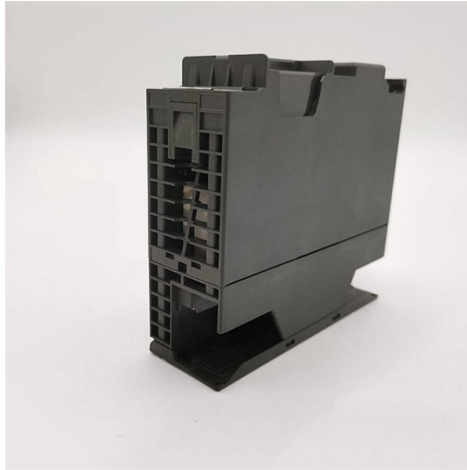


How to connect temporary power to the secondary distribution box
