

How to debug an aggregation switch

To debug an aggregation switch, systematically verify physical connections, port status, LACP configuration, and switch compatibility to identify and resolve LAG or LACP issues.

Step 1: Verify Physical Connections

Ensure that all member ports of the aggregation group are properly connected and free from physical faults. Check for loose cables, damaged ports, or incorrect connections. - Verify that all member ports are in the selected/active state for aggregation. Ports in an unselected state may indicate physical or configuration issues .

Step 3: Validate LACP or LAG Configuration

- Ensure consistent configuration across all member ports, including speed, duplex mode, VLAN settings, and LACP mode (active or passive) .
- Confirm that LACP is enabled on both ends of the link. At least one side should be in active mode to initiate negotiation .
- Check for switch-specific limitations, such as contiguous port requirements or maximum number of aggregated ports .
