

How to find the centerline of a cable tray

Consider Cable Type and Tray Design: Different tray types (ladder, solid bottom, wire mesh) and cable types (fiber optic, armored, PoE bundles) affect how cables sit within the tray. Always measure the centerline along the path that the cables will follow, not the tray edges, to ensure sufficient bend radius and avoid cable damage .

Practical Tips

- Use the Centerline for Bend Calculations: The centerline radius is essential for calculating the minimum bend radius and ensuring compliance with standards like IEC 60364 and NEC Article 392 .
- Allow Extra Margin: When pulling cables, the dynamic radius may be larger than the tray bend radius, especially for fiber optic cables .
