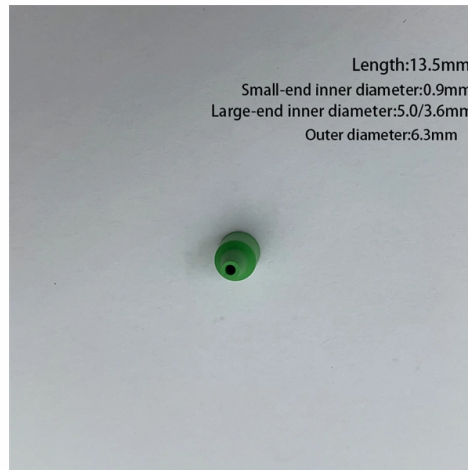


Incoming terminals of the distribution box
