

Large-span bridge in the Netherlands



Overview

The Van Brienenoord Bridge in Rotterdam is the largest bridge in the Netherlands. It was inaugurated on 15. Zierikzee - The Zeeland Bridge, built in 1965, bridges the Oosterschelde between Zierikzee and Colijnsplaat and connects Noord-Beveland with Schouwen-Duiveland in the province of Zeeland. Stretching over 5 kilometers, this impressive bridge connects the islands of Schouwen-Duiveland and Noord-Beveland, playing a vital role in facilitating seamless. With a main span of over 250 metres, the Zandhazen Bridge over the A1 motorway is the longest railway bridge in the country and the first to be constructed from S460 steel. Fun fact: the Zandhazen Bridge contains as much steel as the Eiffel Tower, and it owes its name to the nickname of the.
