

Length requirements for fire-resistant cable trays



Overview

The standard NEMA lengths for cable tray are 12, 20, 24 and 30-feet, although some manufacturers like Eaton offer cable tray in lengths up to 40 feet. 8 (Other Mechanical Stresses (AJ)) in that document provides requirements for cable support. Clause 522-08-04 Where conductors or cables are not supported continuously due to the method of in-stallation, they shall be supported by suitable means at appropriate intervals in such a manner. Where cables pass through shafts, walls, slabs, or enter electrical panels or cabinets, openings shall be tightly sealed with firestopping materials in accordance with design requirements.
