Key Components

A typical low-voltage distribution box includes:

- **Main Switch/Isolator:** Controls incoming power and allows safe isolation of the system .
- **Protective Devices:** Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs), Residual Current Devices (RCDs), RCBOs, fuses, and surge protective devices (SPDs) protect circuits from overloads, short circuits, and electrical faults .
- **Busbars:** Phase busbars distribute power to outgoing circuits; neutral and earth bars provide return paths and grounding .
- **DIN Rails:** Mounting rails for modular devices like MCBs and RCDs .
- **Cable Entries and Wiring Space:** Designed for organized routing and heat dissipation .
