Mandatory Minimum: The NEC requires a minimum of two 20-amp, 120-volt circuits dedicated specifically to the countertop receptacles in your kitchen, pantry, dining room, and similar areas. This "minimum of two" provision ensures ample capacity and redundancy for your everyday. The proper separation of circuits provides service continuity and eases rapid location of fault. National standards commonly recommend the subdivision of circuits according to the number of utilization categories in the installation concerned (see Figure Q10): At least one socket-outlets circuit. The required number of circuits is calculated based on the dwelling's size and the high-power appliances it contains. Electrical codes mandate a minimum number of circuits to safely distribute the total electrical load, ensuring high-demand areas and fixed appliances have dedicated power pathways.
