The sides of trays shall be 180° return flanged for rigidity and minimizing damage to cable sheath and injury. This standard specifies the requirements for nonmetallic cable trays and associated fittings designed for use in accordance with the rules of the Canadian Electrical Code (CEC) Part 1, and the National Electrical Code® (NEC).
