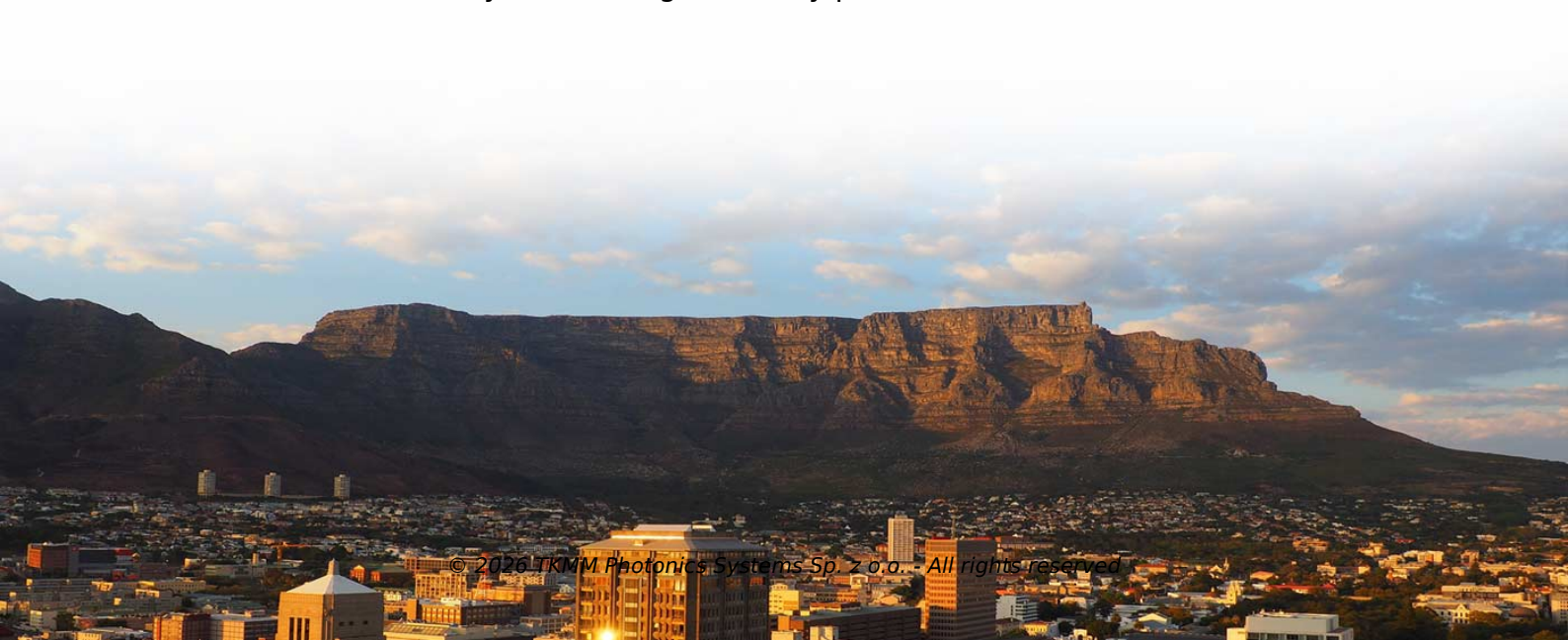


Relay protection certificate validity period

IEC 60255-1:2022 specifies common rules and requirements applicable to measuring relays and protection equipment, including any combination of equipment to form a distributed protection scheme for power system protection such as control, monitoring and process interface equipment, to obtain. National/ International standards does not specify any period for validity of type test results. It ensures that the protection relays used in the system will at least have performed all the tests required in the standard and will also be covered by the essential declarations that relay

How often should protection relays be tested?

According to ANSI/NFPA 70B, relays in industrial settings should be tested every two years. IEC and other standards dictate a maximum of three years between tests.

By law, protective relay calibration is required once every two years

Certification of Protective Relay Applications and Settings

Data will be retained in electronic form for at least one year. The retention period will be evaluated before expiration of one year to determine if a longer retention period is necessary.

Certification Bodies for Relay Protection

The main objective of relay protection certification is to ensure that protective devices are capable of identifying and isolating faults within specified time limits.
