- SFP+: Supports up to 10 Gbps, commonly used in data centers and enterprise networks .
- SFP28: Supports 25 Gbps, designed for high-speed aggregation and modern 100G networks .
- SFP112: Emerging standard for low-power, high-efficiency applications in green data centers .
