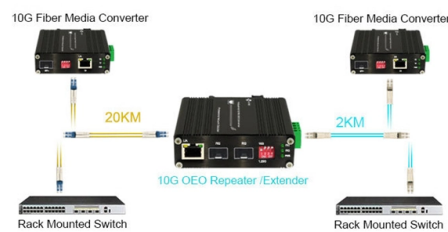

Types of Leakage Protection Devices

- **Residual Current Device (RCD)** An RCD interrupts the circuit when it detects an imbalance between the live (phase) and neutral conductors, indicating leakage to ground. It is designed to protect people from electric shock and prevent damage to equipment by disconnecting the circuit quickly, usually within 30 milliseconds for currents as low as 5-30 mA ().
- **Residual Current Circuit Breaker (RCCB)** RCCBs are a type of RCD that specifically detect earth leakage currents without providing overcurrent protection. They are commonly used in secondary distribution boxes to protect circuits where the risk of electric shock is high ().
- **Earth Leakage Circuit Breaker (ELCB)** ELCBs detect leakage currents to earth and disconnect the supply. Modern electronic ELCBs function similarly to RCCBs but may include additional monitoring features. They are used in areas with high humidity, metal structures, or high fire risk ().
- **Residual Current Breaker with Overcurrent Protection (RCBO)** RCBOs combine the functions of an RCD and a miniature circuit breaker (MCB), providing both leakage protection and overcurrent protection in a single device. This is particularly useful in secondary distribution boxes to protect individual circuits from both overloads and earth faults ().
