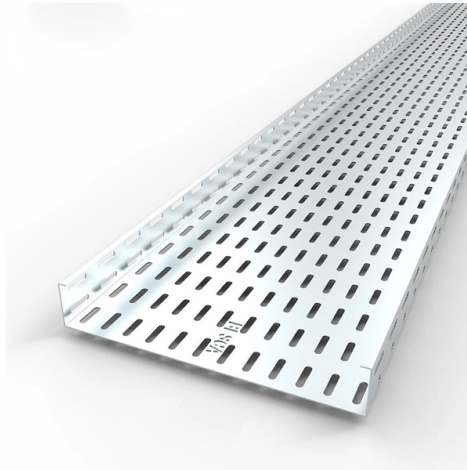


Technical Support for Fiber Ethernet Switches QSFP



AI Overview

QSFP modules provide high-speed, high-bandwidth connectivity for Ethernet switches, and proper support requires attention to module type, fiber compatibility, and switch port specifications.

Understanding QSFP Modules and Ports

QSFP (Quad Small Form-factor Pluggable) modules are hot-pluggable transceivers that combine four independent electrical channels into a single compact form factor, enabling scalable bandwidth from 40 Gbps to 400 Gbps depending on the generation (QSFP+, QSFP28, QSFP-DD) and signaling method (NRZ or PAM4). QSFP ports are designed for high-performance, high-bandwidth connections, making them ideal for core switches, data center interconnects, and high-speed server links.

- QSFP28 supports 100 Gbps aggregate bandwidth using 25 Gbps per lane.
- QSFP-DD (Double Density) supports 400 Gbps using 8 lanes of 50 Gbps PAM4 signaling and is backward compatible with QSFP28 and QSFP+ modules if the switch supports proper electrical signaling.
- QSFP+ supports 40 Gbps using 10 Gbps per lane.
