

Tunisia fiber optic cable cut



Overview

Due to severed network cables in the Red Sea, Microsoft's Azure cloud service is currently experiencing increased latency. The problems have existed since Sunday night. Only data traffic that flows through the Middle East and starts or ends in Europe or Asia is affected. Microsoft's Azure cloud platform is facing significant network disruptions following multiple undersea fiber optic cable cuts. DUBAI, United Arab Emirates (AP) — A ship likely cut cables in the Red Sea that disrupted internet access in Africa, Asia and the Middle East, experts said Tuesday, showing the lines' vulnerability over a year after another incident severed them. The International Cable Protection Committee told. Tunisie Telecom is the leading provider of international internet connectivity. The company manages three sub-sea cables, including a 112-mile fiber-optic cable connecting the city of Kelibia in Tunisia with the Italian city of Mazara. International bandwidth capacity grew from 82.5 Gbps in 2012 to about 1,710 Gbps in 2023. 5G licensing occurred in September 2024.
