Drop-Outs: Allow cables to exit the tray vertically to connect to equipment below.

Cable Tray Supports: These include trapeze hangers, center-span supports, and wall brackets that anchor the entire system to the building structure (ceiling, wall, or floor). Support components like Splice Plates/Couplers join straight sections securely, while Hold Down Clamps and Support Brackets fix the tray to walls, floors, or ceiling support systems. Finally, Cable Protection accessories such as Covers shield cables from debris and mechanical damage, and. According to the National Electrical Code standard of the United States, a cable tray is a unit or assembly of units or sections and associated fittings forming a rigid structural system used to securely fasten or support cables and raceways. A complete system is made up of. A metal strip constructed to divide a section of cable tray so that certain kinds of cable may be separated from each other. They can easily be moved, reconfigured, or expanded as needed to meet changing requirements and evolving connectivity needs.
