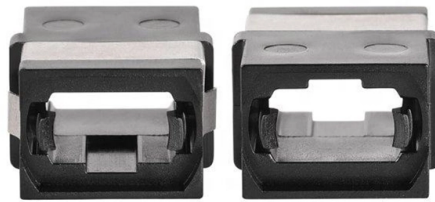


# What is the interface of an SFP optical module



## AI Overview

SFP optical modules use a standardized electrical interface with a defined pinout and I<sup>2</sup>C-based management for communication with the host device.

### Physical and Electrical Interface

SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) modules are hot-pluggable transceivers that connect to network devices such as switches, routers, and servers via a modular SFP slot. The interface is defined by Multi-Source Agreements (MSAs), which standardize the mechanical dimensions, pinout, and electrical signaling to ensure interoperability across vendors. The module converts electrical signals from the host into optical signals for fiber links (or copper signals for RJ-45 SFPs) and vice versa.

### Pinout and Communication

The SFP module communicates with the host through a 10-pin electrical interface, which includes:

- Transmit and receive differential pairs for data signals
- Ground and power pins
- I<sup>2</sup>C interface pins for management and monitoring The I<sup>2</sup>C interface allows the host to read the module's EEPROM, which contains information such as vendor, part number, supported speeds, and diagnostic data like temperature, supply voltage, and optical power levels (Digital Diagnostic Monitoring, DDM/DOM) compliant with SFF-8472.
