

What to put on the door of the secondary distribution box

A panelboard is an assembly with buses and overcurrent protective devices (OCPDs) designed to be placed in a cabinet or enclosure [Art. Its function is to expand the capacity and organization of the electrical system, especially when the main panel is full or when power is needed far. A neat, well-organized service panel or subpanel is easier and safer to work in; it will also be an easier panel in which to add circuits later on. Most of the time, each of these secondary circuits will be protected with a fuse or breaker.
