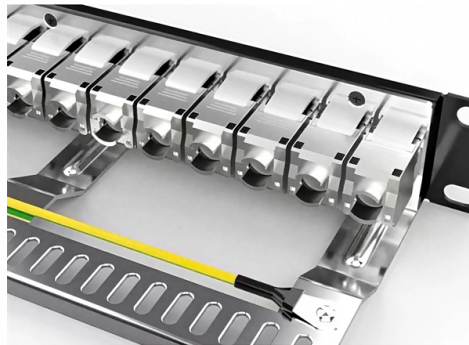


Which optical module cage connector is the best

Key Considerations for Choosing an Optical Module Cage Connector

1. Cage Compatibility and Module Type The cage must match the optical module type. Standard SFP cages support 1G/10G modules, SFP28 cages are optimized for 25G modules, and QSFP/QSFP+/QSFP28/QSFP-DD cages are required for higher-speed multi-fiber modules . Using an incompatible cage can lead to poor signal integrity, overheating, or mechanical issues. 2. Connector Type

- LC (Lucent Connector): The industry standard for most SFP and SFP+ modules. LC connectors use a 1.25mm ferrule, allowing higher port density and compact design, which is critical in modern data centers . They are suitable for both single-mode and multi-mode fiber.

- SC (Subscriber Connector): Larger 2.5mm ferrule, robust and reliable but occupies more space. Typically used in legacy systems or where space is not a constraint .

- RJ45: Used for copper SFP modules, connecting to standard Ethernet cables.

- MPO/MTP: Primarily for QSFP modules supporting multi-fiber parallel optics .

3. Mechanical and Electrical Features A high-quality cage should provide:

- Secure physical housing to prevent module movement
